Frequently Asked Questions

1. What is the BCSC funding this year?

- a. Educational Programming
- b. Readiness and Resilience

These two categories include but, are not limited to school groups, educational clubs, clubs, sports teams and community organizations. The BCSC is especially interested in projects/events/programs that have high impact on the community both in the number of people served and the depth of the impact upon each participant.

2. I work for MWR, can we apply for a grant?

No, only private organizations on post are allowed to apply for grants. That would include organizations like: Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, USO, Red Cross, Contact Club, etc. etc.

3. My club has a trip to send just one person to “space camp”, can we apply for a grant?

No, the intent of the community grants is that they benefit the whole community. Sending one person on a trip that will mainly improve that person's knowledge. It will not qualify for the grant if that person doesn't use their knowledge to benefit the community.

4. I am a Boy/Girl Scout and I am planning for my Eagle Scout Project or Gold Award Project; can I apply for a grant?

Yes, Boy and Girl Scouts can apply for funding for their large-scale community projects. A description of the project and community impact must be included in the grant application along with a full grant application.

5. If I turn in my application late, can I still get funding?

No, the application deadline is March 31st at midnight.

6. Do I have to be a member of the Bavaria Community and Spouses Club to apply for a community grant?

No, grant opportunities are provided to the whole community regardless of membership in the BCSC.

7. What sort of things will the BCSC not fund?

We are not allowed to fund:

- Other organizations fundraisers (ex. funding for an FRG to hold a bake sale)
- The purchase of alcohol, tobacco or firearms or fire works
- Transportation of any kind due to liability concerns
- Individual programs or trips; these grants are meant for organizations and groups of community members.
- Note: FRGs are limited to \$1,000 during the BCSC fiscal year (1 June 2018 - 31 May 2019).

8. The application requests a full-budget, does this mean the budget for our whole year of operation?

No. The full-budget is for the project/program for which you are applying. We do NOT need your whole organizational budget. However, if you are requesting funds for an event you must include all of the line-items in your budget and then indicate for which items you are requesting funding.
