VOLUNTEERS

How can I sign up to be a volunteer at the Crown Jewel Bazaar?

What type of Volunteer positions are available?

- Yes, you will earn \$5 Bazaar Bucks (but no more than \$45 in Bazaar Bucks) for each shift you work. These Bucks can be used to pay for items at any Vendor that is set-up throughout the Bazaar.

Risk Mitigation Measures

What measures are being taken to protect customers shopping at the Bazaar?

- Vendors will be wearing face coverings at all times; they will wipe down frequently touched surfaces regularly and they will keep 6ft distance between the customer and themselves.
- Customers will have to wear a face covering prior to entering the building and have to sanitize their hands. There are hand sanitation stations set-up throughout the building.

Are Shoppers able to taste the product the Vendors sell, like Cheese and Wine?

- Absolutely. The Vendors will hand out individual samples upon request.

The Bazaar is always so cramped and barely any space to walk. Will there be a better solution this year so customers can maintain distance?

- Yes, there is a max number of Customers that can enter the building at the same time. The Vendors are spaced out enough to ensure social distancing is possible.
