Board Year: 2025-2026

- ❖ 18 members, and 3 Advisors served on the Board of Governors
- ❖ Board of Governors led a membership of 211 people

Major Board Accomplishments

- Set and operated within an approved budget of \$32,265.00
- Hosted 9 General Membership Meetings (Luncheons & Evening Events) with an average attendance of 40 members.
- Led 7 sub-clubs, hosting 52 events with an average attendance of 8 members.
- Raised \$1355.00 from our Ways and Means table
- The Grafenwoehr and Vilseck Thrift stores raised over \$143,000 for future Grants and scholarships
 - Community Grant Program awarded \$72784.18 to 42 organizations
 - Scholarship Program awarded \$96,000 to 9 High School Seniors and 10 Dependents for continuing education.
- Charitable Giving
 - Total contributions amount to \$199,444.57
 - \$21,041 presented to 11 community partners as in-kind donations through the Community Enhancement Program. \$5000 was used to purchase gift cards for teachers during a government shutdown. \$5000 was used to purchase gift cards were given at random to Graf & Vilseck Commissary shoppers. \$644 was used to the American Red Cross for CPR training mannequins. \$1000 was used to purchase clothing racks were bought and donated to Freecycle. \$390 was used to purchase a bond to start up a VHS PTSA. \$602 was used to purchase cookies and cocoa for the Vilseck and Grafenwoehr tree lightings. \$1000 was used to purchase food for the CYS Fine Arts Banquet. \$937 was used to purchase Stars and Stripes subscriptions that allows soldiers to get the paper for free at USO's.

\$986 was used to purchase Color Run refreshments. \$2800 purchased AWAG scholarships. \$2682 purchased Kinderfest T-shirts.

- The Bright Eyes Program awarded \$8925 to 93 recipients toward the purchase of glasses for youth
- The PEARL Program awarded \$694 to 2 recipients toward professional recertifications
- Volunteer Recognition Ceremony
 - 20 Volunteers were recognized at our annual Volunteer Appreciation Luncheon.
 - 8,978 service hours were contributed by Bavaria Community Spouses' Club members and community members, including Vilseck High School students, in support of community and fundraising events.
 - 4,305 service hours were contributed by the Board of Governors, 48% of the total hours.
 - 7 BCSC members were nominated for USAG Bavaria Volunteer of the Year Award for either their service to BCSC or other organizations across USAG Bavaria. One BCSC board member was awarded the USAG Bavaria Volunteer of the Year Award.
- Social Media
 - Facebook posts had 439.4K views, 232,511 from followers and 206,845 from non-followers, and 5.6K content interactions, an 8.1% increase. Top content by views consisted in order of highest to lowest: Freecycle cleanout, Free Shopping Day at Vilseck, Volunteer Recognition Ceremony, Fall events and Scholarship recipient highlights.
 - Instagram saw 20.8k views and reached 1.6k people, a 1.6% increase and 339 content interactions, a 100% increase. Top content by views consisted solely of Scholarship recipient highlights.
 - Website had 17,237 site visitors, average pages per visit is 1.47
- The Crown Jewel Bazaar was cancelled this year by MWR due to a government shutdown. No major fundraising occurred with this event.
